Where do I get the bus/train home?

There are bus stops directly outside the school. All students who get the bus home must get on the bus using these bus stops. Teachers are on duty at the bus stops after school. You need to make a queue when waiting for the bus after school.

The 245 or the 483 buses go past the school. North Wembley Station is less than a 10 minute walk away and is served by the London Underground (Bakerloo and Overground). Some students may walk or get the bus to Sudbury Town Underground Station (Piccadilly line).

Crossing the road

Your safety is the highest priority for all staff members at our school. Students are only permitted to use designated crossings which are supervised by staff members. There is a crossing directly outside school (see below) and a zebra crossing on East Lane for students to use. Your parents are not allowed to double park outside school. They can wait in the cark park opposite the school.
